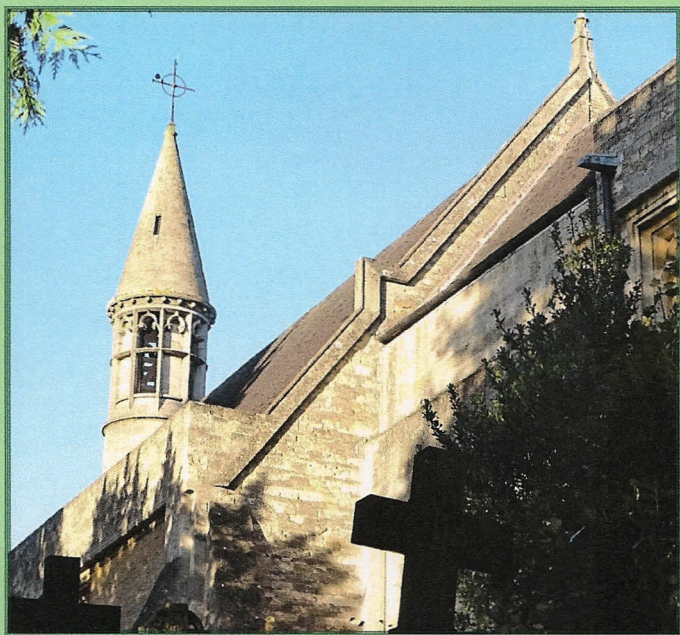
These are potentially exciting developments for the church and will need considerable funds to bring to fruition.
